

§ 194-2 **Refuse containers.**

**A.**

For household garbage and rubbish. Every householder shall provide and maintain in proper order for the purpose of sorting and putting out for collection of garbage a sufficient number of tightly sealed containers having a capacity of not more than 30 gallons each. No container shall have a height greater than 36 inches or less than 18 inches or shall have a diameter larger than 20 inches or smaller than 15 inches, and no container shall weigh more than 50 pounds, including contents.

§ 194-5 **Maximum quantity of collectible waste.**

**A.**

Residential. The number of containers or bundles put out for collection from any single-family or duplex dwelling is limited to two per family.

**B.**

Commercial/multifamily dwellings. The number of containers and bundles placed for collection from any other premises shall not exceed seven for each collection.

**C.**

Maximum quantity. Under circumstances where both Subsections **A** and **B** above apply, the maximum number of containers that may be put out for collection shall not exceed nine containers.
