Thank you for your letter dated January 15, 2021 signaling Atlantic Broadband's interest in renewing its cable TV franchise with the City of Laconia.

Please be advised, The City of Laconia has initiated a process to ascertain the cable-related needs and interests of our community and auditing the performance of Atlantic Broadband and its predecessor, MetroCast, under the existing franchise agreement, in preparation for renewal negotiations with Atlantic Broadband.
