

## STAFF REPORT

*May 24, 2021*

**Topic:** First reading of Resolution 2021-12, relative to making itemized appropriations for the following City Special Revenue Funds – Motorcycle Week Fund and Ambulance EMS Fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021 and terminating June 30, 2022

**Discussion:** The proposed FY22 budget was presented to the City Council on April 26, 2021. Per Section 5:04 of the City Charter, a public hearing must be held prior to the adoption of the budget by the Council to allow for public input and discussion. This is the first reading of the Special Revenue Fund budgets and resolution. Scheduling of the budget public hearing with the second reading will follow.

**Fiscal Impact:** The proposed Motorcycle Week Special Revenue Fund budget and Ambulance EMS Special Revenue Fund budget include estimated revenues and expenses for FY22.

**Staff Recommendation:** The City Manager recommends the City Council approve this resolution as presented.
