Topic: Second reading of Resolution 2021-12, relative to making itemized appropriations for the following City Special Revenue Funds – Motorcycle Week Fund and Ambulance EMS Fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021, and terminating June 30, 2022

Discussion: The proposed FY22 budget was presented to the City Council on April 26, 2021. Per Section 5:04 of the City Charter, a public hearing was held prior to the adoption of the budget by the Council to allow for public input and discussion. This is the second reading of the Special Revenue Fund budgets and resolution.

Fiscal Impact: The proposed Motorcycle Week Special Revenue Fund budget and Ambulance EMS Special Revenue Fund budget include estimated revenues and expenses for FY22.
