Topic: RFQ for Urban Planning Services for downtown Laconia parking study

Discussion: At their January 10, 2022 meeting the City Council agreed to initiate the process for an urban planner to look at downtown parking, current pedestrian pathways, lighting, safety, economic development, public-private initiatives and underutilized parcels.
