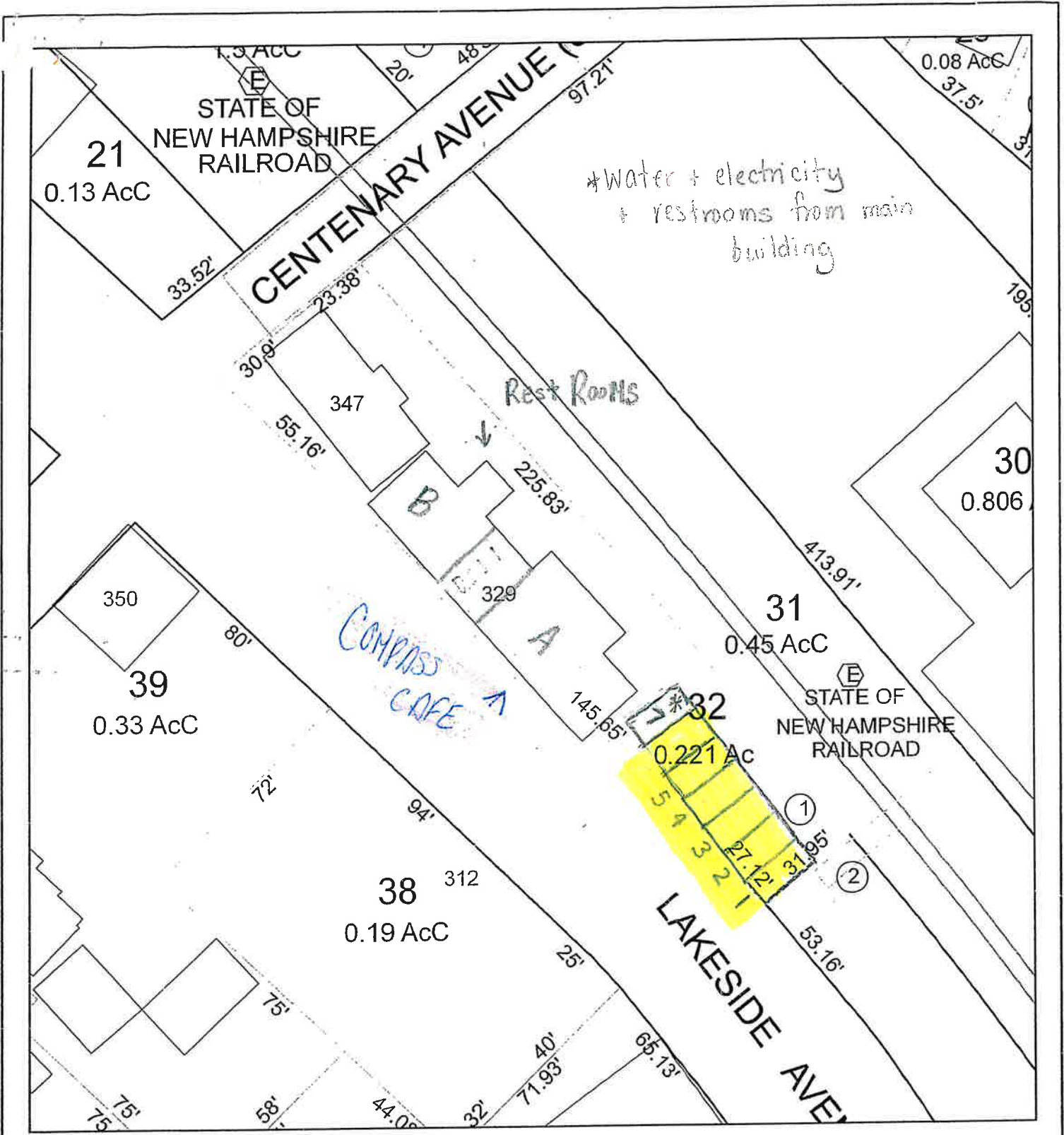

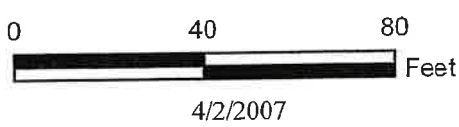

FOR 4 VENDOR SITES AND TEMPORARY PARKING  
MEETING OF MAY 5, 2021**

In accordance with Chapter 195 of the City Code, this notice is to certify that on May 5, 2021, your application to the City of Laconia's Special Event Committee was approved. Application PL2021-0041MC 329 Lakeside Ave has been granted conditional approval for one vendor site, as shown in the application received April 6, 2021 with the following conditions:

1. The applicant shall ensure the required 3-foot setback from the City right-of way is maintained.
2. No retail racks can be placed in roadway and must allow appropriate spacing for pedestrian traffic.
3. Property representative shall be on site when the vendors are operating.
4. Applicant is required to provide trash removal from the entire site. This may include sharing a dumpster with 279 Lakeside and/or the Crazy Gringo. The dumpsters must be accessible at all times.
5. Restroom facilities for the vendors are in the Weirs Beach General Store.
6. Applicant shall keep pedestrian area free of vendor waste and displays. Each interior vendor space shall meet the LFD and Life Safety Code minimum for marking, illumination and number of exits. A site inspection is required.
7. Security plan to include the prevention of tailgating and loitering along any public way on private property.
8. Parking space # 7 is to be kept open for use by restaurant patrons only.
9. If there are food vendors, a plan showing the location of propane tanks must be presented one week prior to the start of Bike Week.
10. A back-flow preventer must be inspected at least one week prior to the start of Bike Week.
11. Electrical extension cords shall be rated at least 15 amp, 125V, UL listed, heavy duty outdoor use; no electrical cords are to be wound along any fencing.
12. In the event that the length of cord required exceeds the standard length (25', 50', 100') the next longest length cord shall be utilized. Only single cords shall be allowed; no coupling of cords will be allowed.
13. There is to be no vending from Unit B.
14. No overnight camping allowed on site.
15. Emergency contact number is Lance or Noula Thibault at 978-973-3618.
16. All temporary structures and all temporary signs including but not limited to banners, portable signs, and changeable copy MUST be removed by June 25, 2021.
17. All aspects of this site shall comply with Chapter 195 and Appendix A and Appendix B.
18. Property owner voluntarily agrees not to allow Dyno-tuners on site at any time during Motorcycle Week.
19. The applicant will be required to separate all cardboard from their solid waste stream and deposit the cardboard into containers supplied by the city which will be marked as "cardboard only". Cardboard cannot be stockpiled in close proximity to the building.
20. Each vendor tent needs a sanitizing station in the front.
21. Each vendor's license needs to be obviously displayed.

The Special Event Committee enforces the above-stated land use approval and will conduct spot inspections throughout Motorcycle Week. The SERC has authority to suspend an approval at any time and impose fines up to \$500 per violation per day if the site does not comply with the approved plan and conditions of approval under Section 195-10 of the Special Events Ordinance.
