Timberman 70.3 Triathlon - September 18, 2022 - City of Laconia and Opechee Park

Overview Information: A 70.3 triathlon is a three discipline sporting event starting with a 1.2 miles swim (Lake Opechee), followed by a 56 mile bike (beginning and finishing at Opechee Park, traveling south of Laconia towards Loudon), and finishing with a 13.1 mile half marathon (two, counter-clockwise loops around Lake Opechee and finishing in downtown Laconia).

Venue Information: The base for all operations (athlete packet pick-up, transition, merchandise, expo, etc) is Opechee Park. Please note that Merchandise and Expo may be moved closer to the finish line area. Once confirmed, I will send along an update. There is a potential for use of the Middle School for some components. Our supply area, consisting of two 53' trailers, would be in the Middle School parking lot. While he detailed layout is not yet developed, we do have a sense of the number and sizes of tents that may be utilized. This is somewhat dependent on how we may utilize the school and if there are any COVID protocols in place at the time of the event. Tents may include:

- One 40x80
- One 40x160
- One 30x60
- One 20x40
- Two 20x40
- Ten-fifteen 10x10 pop up tents
- Additional tent for the medical in the municipal lot near Wayfarer Coffee, 20x40

Finish Line Information: The finish line is slated to be on Main Street, adjacent Wayfarer Coffee Shop with participants finishing from south to north. A medical triage tent would be available in the municipal lot adjacent.

Event Timeline:

- Monday, September 12th (if not earlier) Key staff arrives including Race Director, Supply Coordinator, Site Coordinator, Volunteer Coordinator
- Monday September 12th (if not earlier) Site/equipment trailers arrived, Supply Coord.
 Begins receiving shipments
- Tuesday, September 13 Wednesday, September 14 all other staff arrives including (3-4)
 Swim Coordinators, (4-5) Bike Coordinators, (3-4) Run Coordinators, (4-6) Site Coordinators,
 Radio Command Coordinator, Athlete Service staff, Merchandise staff, etc
- Wednesday, September 14 Build out of the venue begins at Opechee Park
- Thursday, September 15 Final all agency meeting with any/all public safety officials to review plans and make final adjustments as needed
- Friday, September 16 Venue build out complete before noon, ready for expo and packet pick up opening from 5-7 at Opechee Park
- Saturday, September 17 Main Street from Hanover to Church Street closed to begin finish line build out

Race Day: Sunday, September 18 (approx. times) Main Street from Beacon to Church closed

4:00am - Athletes begin arriving at transition (Opechee Park)

7:00am - Swim start

7:20am - First swimmer out of water

7:25am - First bike on the road

8:30am - Last swimmer out of the water

9:40am - First bike returns to transition (Opechee Park)

9:45am - First runner begins run route

1:45pm - Last bike returns to transition (Opechee Park)

4:30pm - Last finisher
