



**Temporary Traffic Control Order
2022-16
Holiday Parade – November 27, 2022**

According to the provisions of Chapter 221, Section 53 of the Laconia City Ordinances, the City Council hereby adopts the following Temporary Traffic Order in connection with the Holiday Parade on November 27, 2022:

1. No parking or vehicular traffic shall be permitted on that portion of North Main Street beginning at Pleasant Street (North of Opechee Park) to Oak Street except local traffic and parade participants traveling south on North Main Street. This portion of the order shall become effective at 2:00 pm and expire at 5:30 pm.
2. No parking or vehicular traffic shall be permitted on that portion of North Main and Main Street beginning at Oak Street to Union Avenue. This portion of the order shall become effective at 4:30 pm and expire at 6:00 pm.
3. No vehicular parking shall be permitted on that portion of Main St. beginning at Church St. to Beacon Streets East and West. This portion of the order shall become effective at 2:00 pm and expire at 6:00 pm.
4. No vehicular traffic shall be permitted on that portion of Court Street beginning at Main Street to Academy Street. This portion of the order shall become effective at 4:30 pm and expire at 6:00 pm.
5. No vehicular traffic shall be permitted on that portion of Union Ave beginning at Lyman St to Church St. This portion of the order shall become effective at 4:30 pm and expire at 6:00 pm.
6. No vehicular traffic shall be permitted on that portion of Church Street beginning at Union Ave. to Main St. This portion of the order shall become effective at 4:30 pm and expire at 6:00 pm.

7. No vehicular traffic shall be permitted on that portion of Beacon Street East beginning at Main Street to Hanover Street. This portion of the order shall become effective at 10:00 am and expire at 7:00 pm.
8. No vehicular parking shall be permitted on that portion of Beacon Street East beginning at Main Street to Hanover Street. This portion of the order shall become effective at 6:00 am and expire at 7:00 pm.
9. The Laconia Police Department will provide personnel to assist in re-routing traffic between the hours of 2:00 pm and 6:00 pm.
10. The Main Street parking lot in downtown Laconia will be closed for general parking for the purpose of locating approximately eight food trucks in that location. The event organizers will ensure that access remains available to the parking spaces designated for the Colonial Theatre condominium residents. This portion of the order shall become effective at 7:00 am and expire at 10:00 pm.
