## **OPERATION PLAN:**

- **The City will program the two parking kiosks at the beach to turn off at the specific start times on the specific dates indicated above. Wes Anderson has confirmed with the kiosk programmers that this is doable. WAC will not charge anyone who shows a valid Laconia beach sticker.**
- **WAC will install signage very early in the morning on the day of the fireworks (or very late at night the night before) that would state that cars parked after 8pm would be subject to the fireworks parking fee of \$10. There would be a sign at the Rt 3 entrance, at the gazebo, and signs on the kiosks themselves. After the fireworks, WAC would remove the signage.**

**For the 8pm shows, the signs on the kiosks would read:**

**FIREWORKS TONIGHT AT 10PM  
FIREWORKS PARKING BEGINS AT 8PM  
FIREWORKS PARKING FEE IS \$10  
FEE HELPS PAY FOR THE FIREWORKS**

• **A few cars might remain after 8pm. WAC would place tickets under their wiper asking them to see the attendant upon departure. WAC doesn't expect to collect from everybody who is still there after 8pm. Most will pay the fee willingly, knowing the money is going directly to pay for the fireworks.**

• **WAC would allow people to go online and reserve a space in advance for \$20. WAC wouldn't be able to guarantee a specific space, but WAC could block off a number of spaces for those reserving in advance. WAC might also block off a space or spaces for major fireworks sponsors, depending on their sponsorship level.**
