Topic: Third reading and approval of Resolution 2019-16, relative to authorizing the City Manager to take any actions necessary to issue bonds for Court Street Reconstruction Phase 2, Fire Engine Replacement and adding a new Public Works truck in the amount of \$2,025,000

Discussion: The proposed bonding of the Court Street Reconstruction Phase 2, and Fire Engine Replacement were included in the budget presented to the Council on April 8, 2019. Low interest rates provide an opportunity to bond these projects at a rate below what had originally been anticipated. The Resolution is presented at this time to allow the City Manager to take advantage of these reduced rates, which may not be available when the City budget is approved.

Fiscal Impact: The City has secured a 2.05% interest rate for a 10 year bond.

Staff Recommendation: The City Manager recommends approving this resolution authorizing bonds for capital projects in the amount of \$2,025,000.
