Topic: Temporary Traffic Order 2019-10 - Belknap Mill's request to reserve parking in connection with the "Sock Hop in Rotary Park" on September 6, 2019

Discussion: The Belknap Mill has requested that all of the reverse angled parking spots on Beacon Street East adjacent to the Belknap Mill and Rotary Park be reserved for the event by use of cones and/or barricades provided by the Department of Public Works on September 6, 2019 from 6:00 am to 8:00 pm.

The "Sock Hop in Rotary Park" will close out the Arts in the Park summer series and will feature live music from the Rockin' Daddios, The Hawk radio station with a live broadcast, and up to five vintage 50s/60s vehicles. The parking spaces are necessary to accommodate the vintage vehicles as well as vehicles related to the band and the radio station. The request to begin reserving the spaces at 6:00 am will guarantee that the spaces are available when needed.
