Topic: Request to use space on the Boardwalk for vending in conjunction with the dates of Biketemberfest

Discussion: Grave Robber Industries, a Gilmanston, NH company that makes reflective apparel and accessories, is requesting the use of space on the Boardwalk to sell their products on in conjunction with the dates of Biketemberfest (9/13 – 9/15/19). Hours of vending that are requested are from 10 am to 10 pm. Cost to the applicant for use of the two 12' x 10' vending spaces on the Boardwalk for the three days requested will be \$450. The appropriate vending license will be obtained from the Licensing Department. A portion of the profits from sales will go to a free Thanksgiving dinner provided to area veterans and others who may have nowhere to go on the holiday.

The spaces on the Boardwalk will be marked by City staff and are in the same vicinity as the food vendor spaces during Motorcycle Week. Please refer to the attached map.

Grave Robber Industries will provide the City with a certificate of liability insurance naming the City as an additional insured in an amount not less than \$1 million.
