

LACONIA WATER DEPARTMENT
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
JANUARY 31, 2020


Chairman Dennis Bothamley called the meeting of the Laconia Water Department Board of Commissioners to order at 9:00 am in the conference room at the water treatment facility at 117 Stark Street. Present were Commissioners Dennis Bothamley, Joe Driscoll, Greg Page, Mayor Andrew Hosmer, Wes Anderson, and also attending was Marco Phillipon who supervises the Concord, New Hampshire water treatment plant.

The commissioners discussed the interview process and reviewed the questions to be asked of the candidates.

At 9:30 am, Greg Page made a motion to have the Board go into a non-public session (according to RSA 91-A:3, II(b) the hiring of any person as a public employee) to interview candidates for the position of Superintendent of the Water Department, which was seconded by Wes Anderson. All Commissioners voted in favor of the motion.

At 4:12 pm, Wes Anderson made a motion to adjourn the non-public session and to seal the minutes of said session for one year. The motion was seconded by Greg Page. All commissioners (Mayor Andrew Hosmer had to leave during the non-public session) voted in favor of the motion.

The Board came out of the non-public session at 4:12pm. Wes Anderson made a motion to adjourn. Joe Driscoll seconded the motion. It passed unanimously.
