Dennis suggested regular get-togethers to share stories. Others were intrigued with his idea.

Just as families learn about themselves is through family stories; so too communities learn through the stories they tell themselves. The problem is that some voices in a community are drowned out such as the elderly, those with disabilities and other diverse groups. We might even consider partnering with Wayfarer or the Mill for a venue. Perhaps we need a community Ted Talks but for regular citizens.
