Don't let a candle ruin your home....



In the past few years there has been a very high increase in the number of home fires caused by candles. There are more than 11,000 home structure fires reported each year that are caused by candles. These fires caused an annual average of 126 deaths and 954 injuries. One-third of these fires started in bedrooms, which caused more than 40% of all the deaths. The worst month of the year is December. The worst three days are Christmas Eve, Christmas Day and New Year's Day. We know the risks associated with candles, hopefully now so do you.

Be very careful when using candles!

Here are some tips for the safe use of candles:

- Extinguish all candles when you leave the room or are going to sleep.
- Keep candles 12" away from items that can catch fire, such as drapes, curtains, clothing, newspapers, and Christmas decorations and trees.
- Use sturdy candleholders that won't tip over easily.
- Keep blinds, curtains and drapes away from candles.
- Keep candles away from flammable liquids.
- Trim candle wicks to one-quarter an inch.
- Keep candles out of the reach of children and away from pets, especially a pet's tail.
- Never leave a child unattended in a room with a candle.
- Don't allow children to have candles in their bedrooms.
- Store candles, matches, and lighters up high and out of children's sight.
- Keep a flashlight handy for when the power goes out. Don't walk around with a lit candle.
- Never use a candle when checking pilot lights on heaters.
- Never use candles if medical oxygen is used in the home.
- Remember a candle is a small fire that can spread quickly if it comes into contact with combustible materials – newspaper, Christmas wrapping paper, clothes, table clothes, etc.

If you think you need emergency services do not hesitate to call 911. Time is of the essence in an emergency. The longer you wait to call for help, the less chance we have of mitigating the problem successfully.

Unauthorized Compressed Gas Cylinders

No. HC-2012-4 December 20, 2012

Learning Objective: The student shall be able to identify unauthorized pressure cylinders sold in retail welding kits.

The U.S. Department of Transportation Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration has issued an important safety alert to consumers who are considering the purchase of retail welding kits: The compressed gas cylinders enclosed in the kits are not authorized for use in the U.S.

These welding kit cylinders do not meet U.S. DOT specifications and are not authorized for hazardous materials service in the U.S. They have not been inspected nor tested for safety, potentially posing danger to individuals and property. Extensive property damage, serious personal injury, and/or death could result from a rupture of one of these cylinders.

Individuals and companies in possession of unauthorized welding kit cylinders are warned not to fill them with any hazardous materials. Filling unauthorized cylinders is punishable by civil penalty and/or criminal prosecution.

Characteristics of unauthorized welding kit cylinders include:

- The welding kits contain two high-pressure cylinders.
- Cylinders are stenciled with "Made in China" in white lettering on the side near the bottom.
- Cylinders do not have markings that identify their type or service pressure.
- Cylinders are similar in appearance to DOT 3A or 3AA and DOT 8A (steel) cylinders, which would commonly contain oxygen and acetylene used in oxyacetylene welding but do meet requirements for maintenance, retest and certification.

Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration has notified directly more than 300 purchasers who obtained the equipment through an online buying service between July 2011 and August 2012.

If you haven't already ordered and picked up your 64 gal. recycling container, now is a great time to do so!

The toters are commercial grade, and have a capacity of 64 gallons. The cost for one toter is \$25 (the City supports \$20 of the total cost of the toter). Additional toters can be purchased for \$45 each while supplies last.

We now have one of the actual toters here in the lobby of City Hall — feel free to stop by and see the great quality of these recycling containers for yourself!
