

The Laconia Planning Board is considering amending the Table of Dimensional Requirements which is part of the City's Zoning Ordinance. The table defines things like setbacks required in the different zoning districts, minimum lot sizes, and green space requirements. There are a series of proposed changes to the table that have been forwarded from the Master Plan Steering Committee. The changes involve adjustments to green space requirements in multiple zoning districts, changes in minimum lot sizes in two districts, and increases in housing density allowed in two districts.

The proposed changes are aimed at achieving three principal objectives: The first is to bring Laconia's regulations more in line with surrounding communities or other communities elsewhere in NH that are similar to Laconia. The second is to bring more existing lots into conformance with the Zoning Ordinance. The third is to allow existing homes in older neighborhoods to perhaps make some improvements without requiring a variance.

A Public Hearing on the amendments will be held during the Planning Board meeting of June 7, 2022. You can review the proposed table by clicking [here](#).



ANNUAL VETERANS CAMPGROUND

TOUR THIS SATURDAY!

Once a year, the New Hampshire Veterans' Association provides a free public tour of its campground at Weirs Beach, and this year's tour will be held on Saturday, May 14 at 1 p.m., rain or shine.

The tour begins at the Veterans' Association Headquarters on Lakeside Avenue.

The surviving buildings of this unique facility mark close to 140 years of history at this resort community.

Veterans Association Historian Fred Merrill will again lead the tour.

As historical researcher Sally E. Svenson wrote in *Historical New Hampshire*, some years ago, "Distinctive as was the reunion culture at the Weirs, the setting for the annual event was even more singular. While regimental and G.A.R. reunions elsewhere were held in cities or on temporary campgrounds loaned by state governments or local railroads, in New Hampshire the statewide veterans' association oversaw the development of a fixed reunion facility which eventually would house a remarkable cluster of buildings without a parallel elsewhere in the country."

This annual event is being held in partnership with the Laconia Historical and Museum Society.





Union Avenue, Court and Main Street intersection is seen at left, 50 years ago, when Parcels 13 and 14 of the Urban Renewal Project — following removal of Main Street buildings (cleared area in center) — were pending redevelopment as a 'motel' — or perhaps as a supermarket. See this week's '50 Years Ago' in 'Our Yesterdays.' Several buildings remaining in the Rowe Court section, including the South Main Market and the former 'General Knight' House, were also razed over the next four decades. ... AND NOW

The proposal for a supermarket did not prevail and a Ramada Inn, next to the river, received its first guests, July 3, 1974. Over the years, the hostelry had several successive names before becoming today's Best Western Plus Landmark Inn. Among other changes was the opening of Walgreens Pharmacy in early October 2009. 
