THEN ...

This was the Guyer Foundry at 922 North Main Street, as it appeared in the late 1940s or early 1950s. In the early 1970s, during Urban Renewal, the property was being considered as a location for a new Central Fire Station. Owner Frank Guyer, who had established the foundry in 1945, was opposed to having the city take the land and buildings through eminent domain. Ultimately, the site was passed over in favor of land south of Tremont Street, a bit closer to Downtown. (Laconia Historical and Museum Society)



... AND NOW

The foundry was damaged by fire and was torn down in late August 1977. White Oak Terrace condominiums, at 918 North Main St. was erected on the site in 1982. (Julie Hirshen Hart/The Laconia Daily Sun photo)


