



## PROTECTING LOVED ONES FROM SCAMS: REVIEWING MAIL

- Set a reminder for when Medicare Summary Notices (MSNs) or Explanations of Benefits (EOBs), bank statements, or pension payments should arrive to look over and check for suspicious activity.
- Take mail that you know is a scam to your post office so they can send it to the postal inspector.
- Remind your loved one to never send their Social Security number, Medicare number, or banking information to solicitors.
- Remind your loved one to never respond to a sweepstakes letter by sending a check to claim a prize.

# Our yesterdays

## THEN ...

Laconia's 'Lower' Bank, long home to the Peoples National and Laconia Savings banks, is seen on Main Street as it looked at the beginning of the city's Urban Renewal Program, more than a half-century ago. Originally the 1861 Folsom Opera House Block, the structure had been remodeled twice — in 1924, substituting a Colonial revival look for the original ornate brickwork and, in 1939, installing a granite facing on three-quarters of the Main Street side. For many years, the Public Service Co. of New Hampshire was located at the right, next to the Winnipesaukee River. (Laconia Public Library)



## ... AND NOW

This week, back in 1972, the Laconia Housing & Redevelopment Authority received approval to acquire and demolish the building — which was completed in November 1972. Ultimately, the space became part of the new Municipal Parking Garage (seen at right, at an angle from the southwest or river side), which opened, June 21, 1974. (Jon Decker/The Laconia Daily Sun)


