Laconia Water Department Public Hearing

The Laconia Water Department will be holding a public hearing on Tuesday, August 23, 2022, to gather comments on raising its rates on the base rate from \$21.00 to \$25.00 per quarter and the consumption from \$2.35 to \$2.55 per hundred cubic feet (hcf).

This meeting will be held at the Laconia City Hall in Council Chambers, Room 200A beginning at 6:00 p.m.

Operational and maintenance increases have been taking place while simultaneously the volume of water billed has decreased approximately 1.3% per year (or 7.5 million gallons/yr) over the last 15 years. The majority of our customers fall into the single family residential category and the proposed increase will amount to approximately an additional \$36.00 per year per household.

Even after this increase, the average home only pays \$0.97 a day for water or less than 0.5 cents per gallon

The Downtown area that is being studied is bounded by Beacon Streets East and West, and by the River and the railroad tracks.

The presentation will include an analysis of the feasibility and costs of the public's suggestions collected earlier in the process.



THEN ...

West side of Main Street, Laconia, opposite Canal Street, looked like this, around 1906, with false fronts on three of the wooden buildings and a dirt roadway. From the left, the Salvation Army and American Express Co. are at No. 624, then at 626-628, Frank T. Durgin, electrical contractor, No. 630 appears to be unoccupied, and then, at 634-636, E.G. Baker, printer and stationer, with the photography studio of Elwin A. Elsam on the second floor. Close inspection discloses Elsam's sign to be in the form of a 'camera.' (Postcard collectors will recognize Baker's name, as he published a number of local views.) In the distance at right, the spire of the Christian Church is faintly glimpsed. (Laconia Historical and Museum Society)

... AND NOW

The Pemaco Block (named for Thomas J. McIntyre Sr.'s PEoples MArket CO.) at 634 Main St. replaced the four old wooden buildings in 1926. Until 1955, the Gardens Theater operated as a movie house on the upper floors. Over the years, Gerry's, Rogers Store (stationers), Jack C. Sawyer, Sweetland Restaurant and Maharajah's Royalty occupied the ground floor, among others; and, more recently, the Vintage Cafe, Wayfarer Coffee Roasters and Marketplace and Polished & Proper Barbershop. 
