Spring into March at the Laconia Library

Chris Schadler, New Hampshire representative and wild canid ecologist with Project Coyote, will present the program *Becoming Wolf: The Eastern Coyote* in the Northeast at 6:00 pm in the Laconia Public Library's auditorium. Learn about Eastern Coyote behavior, their ecological benefits, and how to coexist with these wild canids as Chris dispels common myths. Chris Schadler has been conducting conservation research and education about wild canids for over 40 years and will discuss coexistence strategies.

Laconia Public Library offers three monthly book groups. The Evening Nonfiction Book Group will meet on Thursday, March 7 at 6:00 pm to discuss "The Barbizon: The Hotel That Set Women Free" by Paulina Bren.
