Summer Reading at Laconia Public Library

June 24th kicks off **Summer Reading** at Laconia Public Library. Adults can pick up a charming book bingo sheet filled with fun suggestions for an adventurous summer of reading. Once the bingo sheet is completed, hand it in at Laconia Public Library to be entered in a drawing for a gift certificate to Laconia Village Bakery.

Grab your kids, grandkids, nieces and nephews and come to the Laconia Library's Garden for an **All-Ages Tie-Dye** party on Tuesday, June 25 at 2pm.

Beginning on Monday May 3, Clare Persson will lead a new 5-week **Beginner Mindfulness Meditation** class at Laconia Public Library. Clare is a licensed Occupational Therapist and a certified Reiki & Mindfulness Meditation
