

State of New Hampshire 2024 Boating Law Changes

The State of New Hampshire has implemented several new boating laws, some effective as soon as August 13, 2024. Significant changes to be aware of include:

- Tubing observation and towing limits
- Engine cut-off switch wear requirement
- Acceptable copy of Boater Education Certificate
- Accident reporting requirements for boat owners
- Penalties for Careless and Negligent and Reckless Operation of Boats





THEN ...

Bank Square, Laconia, is seen in late 1956, when the old storefront — adjoining the 1886 City Savings and Laconia National Bank Building (far left) — was being demolished to make way for an addition to the bank. (Among one-time occupants had been Cottrell's Restaurant and The Nut Shop.) At right, the Laconia Spa still occupies the ground floor of the ancient structure at the corner of Mill Street and Lee's Cut-Rate is glimpsed at far right. (Laconia Historical and Museum Society)



... AND NOW

The Colonial Revival brick facade was part of renovations to the old bank building, in 1957, along with a new three-story addition to Laconia National Bank on the site of the adjoining wooden structure and Peter S. Karagianis moved his Laconia Spa to a new location on Church Street that September. City Savings Bank opened a one-story addition at 575 Main St. in late December 1959. The three-story addition at the rear was built in 1970-1971. Today, the entire property is home to the Lakes Region Mental Health Center. (Daniel Sarch/The Laconia Daily Sun)
