# Laconia Motorcycle Week

Following Weirs Bike Week 2011, the Motorcycle Technical Review Committee (MTRC) proposed a number of revisions to Chapter 195 and Appendix A. The revisions were based on experiences the MTRC has had at previous Bike Weeks and the fact that the State has adopted new regulations for temporary food establishments. Many of the changes in Appendix A simply mirror the State requirements.

There were two public meetings, the first on July 20, 2011 and the second on October 5, 2011. At these meetings the public was welcome to comment on any issues they saw during Bike Week that needed to be addressed. The draft that came out of those meetings was presented to the City Council on Dec.27, 2011, at which time the Council decided more public comment was needed. It is important to note that only the strike-outs and bold language is what will be changing; the rest of the document is what currently exists.

# Updates from the Planning Office...



How often do you think about energy costs? Every time you flick a switch? Whenever you have to fill up your fuel tank or pay a utility bill? Every day? Do you know that for the last four years City staff has been working on and implementing municipal energy efficiency and cost saving activities? **But we now need your help to learn how we can best save energy in Laconia.** The City, with assistance from Lakes Region Planning Commission, is creating an Energy Chapter to include in the City's Master Plan. The Energy Chapter will address existing conditions, energy policies, recommendations and action steps regarding energy efficiency, energy conservation and renewable energy, at both the municipal, business and residential levels. The City wants to hear your suggestions and include them in the Master Plan.

**City residents and businesses, are invited to the Energy Forum on Tuesday June 19<sup>th</sup> from 4:00 to 6:00 PM at the City Council Chambers.** Participants will be asked to work together to help identify Laconia's Energy Future.

## Assessing

The Assessing Office received about 160 +/- applications for abatement this year. This is the process taxpayers can use to dispute their final 2011 value.

After the two Board of Assessors meetings in June, all abatements will be answered; owners will receive a letter with their decision and instructions on the next step of the appeal process.



Now is the time to file for NH State Low and Moderate Income Homeowners Property Tax Relief!

Form DP-8 must be filed no later than June 30!

You are eligible to file for this tax relief if:

- You own a homestead subject to the state education property tax;

- You have resided in such homestead on April 1 of the year for which the claim for relief is made;
- You have a total adjusted gross household income of \$20,000 or less if a single person, or \$40,000 or less if married or head of a NH household.

Be sure to attach a copy of your final 2011 property tax bill and your 2011 federal tax return for each claimant and all adult members of the claimant's household for the corresponding period.

### NOTICE OF RATE CHANGES LACONIA TRANSFER STATION

On May 14, 2012, the Laconia City Council voted to approve the following rate increases at the Laconia Transfer Station effective July 1, 2012 and July 1, 2013 respectively:

- (1) Loads containing up to 100 pounds: \$5 per load
- (2) Loads containing more than 100 pounds: \$60 per ton effective July 1, 2012 and \$90 per ton effective July 1, 2013, calculated in 20 pound increments.

The City of Laconia strongly encourages all Laconia residents and businesses to recycle - by participation in the curbside collection program for those on collection routes, by utilizing the 4 remote drop-off sites around the city (behind 257 Messer St, behind the Lakeport Fire Station, at the Weirs Community Center parking lot, and across from the Memorial Park Club House or, by delivering recyclables directly to the Laconia Transfer Station.

Recycling bins are provided free of charge. There is currently no limit on the amount of recycling which is collected curbside.
