PRESIDENTS' DAY RECOGNITION

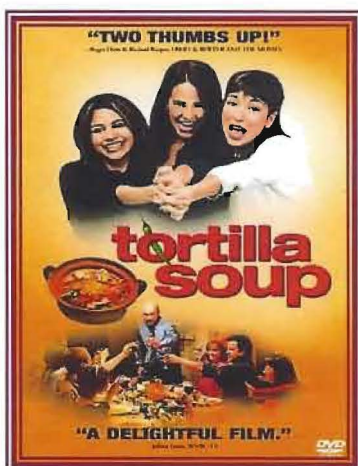
Wednesday, February 22 @ 7pm in the Upper Exhibit Gallery

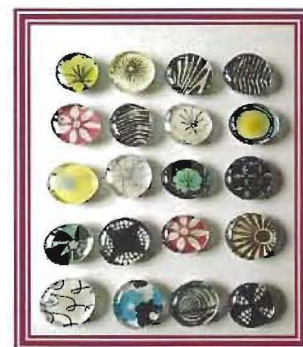
MT WASHINGTON OBSERVATORY: WORLD'S WORST WEATHER

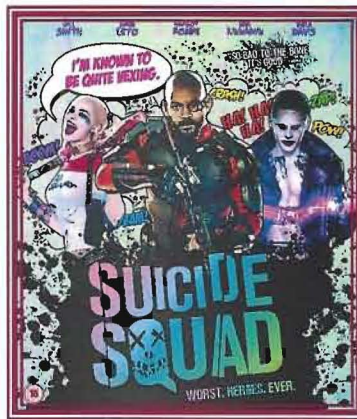
