Convenience fees apply to all credit card transactions. Please call the Tax Office at 527-1269 if you have any questions.

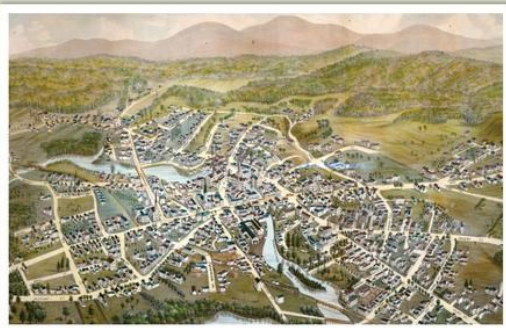
