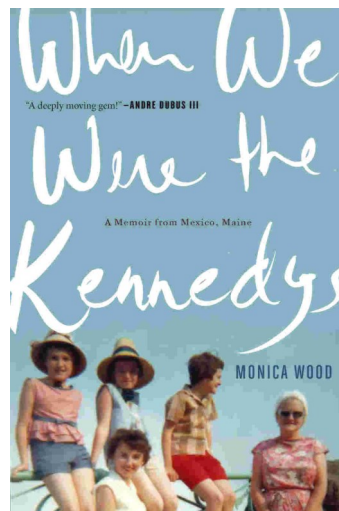
WHEN WE WERE THE KENNEDYS BY MONICA WOOD

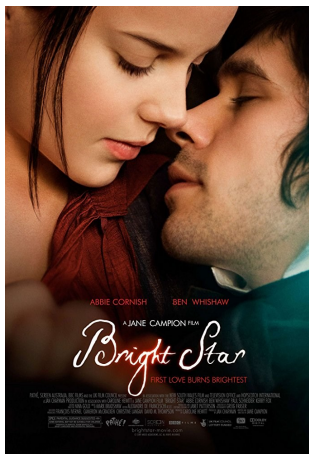

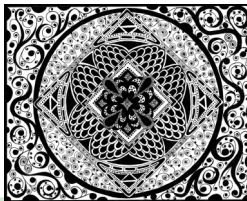
