The City Council requests public comment on the recommended option to improve traffic flow at the Union Avenue/Elm Street intersection at the Feb. 26, 2018 City Council meeting. Public Works is recommending that the southbound Union Avenue area by Fratello's restaurant be changed from a shared through/left turn lane and a right turn only to a shared through/left turn and a shared through right turn. If approved, the changes would be included in the Union Avenue–Elm Street to Stark Street Improvement Project that is tentatively scheduled to begin this fall.

From the Planning Department:

How would you like to help your fellow Laconia citizens? With just a few hours of your time each month you can make a difference and fill an important service. The city currently has an urgent need for people to serve on the Planning Board or the Zoning Board of Adjustment. We need both a regular member and two alternates for the Planning Board and two alternates for the Zoning Board of Adjustment. Usually there is one meeting a month, scheduled in the early evening, that lasts one to three hours (normally).

Alternate members fill in at meetings for regular members that can't make that meeting or for some other reason can't sit on a particular application. Being an alternate member is a great way to learn how the board functions and many times leads to becoming a regular member, if desired. No experience is needed as we will train you. All you need is a willingness to learn and be fair and open minded.

The Planning Board hears applications for a variety of items concerning land use and new development and also forms the city's Master Plan. The Zoning Board of Adjustment is responsible for granting relief to zoning regulations and granting special exceptions. The Planning Board usually meets the first Tuesday of each month with the Zoning Board meets the third Monday of each month.

Any questions about either of these boards can be directed to the Planning Department at 527-1264. Ask for Director Dean Trefethen or Assistant Director Brandee Loughlin. We hope to be hearing from you soon!



CITY OF LACONIA NOTICE SEASONAL 10 TON WEIGHT LIMIT

Effective March 1, 2018 at 6:00 am, trucks whose gross weight exceeds 10 tons are prohibited the use of all streets in the City except for State roads, the City's arterial routes and routes to industrial parks. A map of posted City streets can be found on the [City's website](#).

Trucks over 10 tons may still use roads with seasonal weight limits when issued a permit by the City's Department of Public Works. Permits are granted in two types of situations:

Blanket authorizations for:

- Contractors providing City services such as solid waste and recycling collection
- Private emergency services such as cleaning sanitary sewer lines
- Heating fuel companies such as heating oil and propane

Blanket authorizations cannot be used for any other use except that authorized on the permit.

One-Time permits are typically used for deliveries and collections such as:

- Building supplies, construction equipment, household goods, furniture
- Roll-off solid waste containers
- Automobiles to dealerships

Pothole Season is Here!

The City of Laconia, like most New England communities, is now experiencing one of the earliest and worst pothole seasons in years. Massive changes in temperature and large amounts of snowfall result in water seeping beneath the road then freezing and expanding. This puts great stress on the roads and creates perfect pothole conditions.

Our Department of Public Works is out every day with a minimum of two crews (and sometimes a third crew) working to repair potholes on our streets and posting pothole signs to warn drivers. Please use caution and pay close attention to the condition of the streets. We appreciate your patience as we continue our efforts to make the streets safer and easier to travel.




