



# REVERSE ANGLE PARKING



***There is a new way to park in certain areas of downtown Laconia!***

With the new parking style called reverse angle parking or back-in parking, you will back into a space so that the front of your car is facing the street. This method has been used across the country. Reverse angle parking will be coming soon to Beacon Street East and Beacon Street West!

## **Benefits of Reverse Angle Parking**

### **Improved Driver Visibility:**

- When leaving a parking space, drivers are facing forward allowing a better view of traffic and cyclists.
- Drivers do not have to back into traffic blindly when leaving. This makes departures safer, quicker and easier.

### **Accessible Parking and Curb Ramps**

- Accessible parking spaces are provided with direct access to the sidewalk.
- Wheelchair users can load/unload from the vehicle's side or rear, away from the traffic lane.

### **Easier Loading/Unloading:**

- When vehicle doors are open, they block pedestrian access to the travel lane and guide them back to the sidewalk.
- The vehicle's trunk is accessed from the sidewalk, making it safer and more convenient to load/unload items.

### **Traffic Calming**

- On-street parking visually narrows the roadway lane width, contributing to slower speeds and enhancing driver alertness.



### **How does it work?**

Just like parallel parking:


1. Signal a right turn to warn other drivers.
2. Pull past the parking spot and stop.
3. Reverse into the parking spot.

# Caution! Change in Traffic Pattern



The DPW will be changing the travel lanes and parking spaces on Beacon St. East and West in late June. The changes are limited to the marked areas shown on the map. The travel lanes in this area will be reduced to a single lane and the parallel parking will be changed to reverse angle parking (see previous page). The single travel lane will create a "traffic calming effect" and result in slower speeds. The reverse angle parking increases the available parking spaces in this busy downtown area. Public Works will have signs in the area before and after the traffic pattern changes are made. Please be alert while drivers become accustomed to the change!





In this detail from a circa 1920 photo, a trolley car of the Laconia Street Railway prepares to head to Laconia from The Weirs. A little more than a quarter-century earlier, in 1894, the restaurant building at right, at the corner of Tower Street and Lakeside Avenue had just been built as part of the Lakeside Hotel's holdings. ## ... AND NOW

Buildings in the earlier view were all destroyed in the Great Weirs Fire of Nov. 9, 1924, but, eventually, the Lakeside Avenue-Tower Street section was rebuilt. Tarlison's Arcade opened, June 23, 1950, on the site of the earlier restaurant building. The rebuilt Weirs United Methodist Church is seen, just up the hill on Tower Street. ## Weirs sees new cafe, other improvements in 1894

LACONIA — At The Weirs, the hotels (Sanborn's, the Lakeside House, Winnecoette, Aquedoktan and Story's Tavern) had opened for the season, *The Laconia Democrat* reported, 125 years ago this week.

"There has been a marked improvement in buildings and

decorations this season; in fact, every year sees improvements of a nature that will soon place this resort far beyond comparison with others in New Hampshire," the 1894 article continued.

At the Lakeside, the most important change had been "the

tearing away of the old cafe which was connected with the house and the erecting of a new building 45x60 feet on the corner of Lakeside avenue and Tower street."

This "will make it possible for a monster crowd to be fed, as it will have a seating capacity of 300."
