



# Our yesterdays

## THEN ...

Laconia's First Baptist Church, designed by Laconia architect A.L. Davis — on Union Avenue between Spring and Elliott streets — occupied this site from 1895 until the late 1940s. Its congregation, however, had united with the First Free Baptist Church in 1918, and moved to the South Baptist Church location on Court Street, taking its pipe organ with it. ## ...AND NOW

In 1919 — 100 years ago this week — Pitman Manufacturing Co. acquired the church. Later, the Knights of Columbus bought it, a movie theater ("The Palace") and roller skating rink were tenants, and the space was rented out to the local Jewish congregation for Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur services. The church was razed during the late 1940s. Shortly thereafter, in 1950, the St. Jean de Baptiste Society built on the site and their building is now the Salvation Army Citadel. (Thomas P. ## Pitman Hosiery buys church for storage, nursery

LACONIA — Pitman Manufacturing Co. had purchased the First Baptist Church edifice on Union Avenue and would "try a new experiment for Laconia in connection with their hosiery industry, by establishing a nursery and play-room for babies and children of their employees and also a rest room for the employ-

ees themselves," *The Laconia Democrat* reported, 100 years ago this week.

Following the union of the First Baptist and Free (South) Baptist churches, the Union Avenue building, between Elliott and Spring streets, had been up for sale for some time and, it appeared, "there was no other

church organization in the city desirous of acquiring the property," the 1919 article continued.

Similar rest rooms and nurseries "are in successful operation in connection with various industries in many large cities ... An establishment of this kind is a new thing in Laconia and will be watched with interest."
