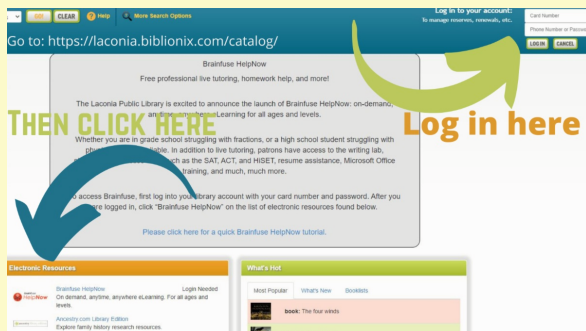

The Laconia Public Library is excited to announce the launch of Brainfuse HelpNow: on-demand, anytime, anywhere eLearning for all ages and levels.

Whether you are in grade school struggling with physics, help is available. In addition to live tutoring, patrons have access to the writing lab, standardized practice tests such as the SAT, ACT, and HiSET, resume assistance, Microsoft Office training, and much, much more.
