Parking at Weirs Beach!

Pease note that parking is now being enforced in Weirs Beach at the two public parking locations:

Lakeside Avenue and Endicott Rock Park.

The City uses kiosks and a "pay by space" system in both locations. Visitors must pay to park between the hours of 9:00 am and 10:00 pm at either location. Please note that the kiosks accept only coins or credit/debit cards.

There are five-hour, three-hour and two-hour parking spaces available on Lakeside Avenue. Parking at these spaces costs \$1.00 per hour.

Endicott Rock Park parking lot has no time limits; it costs \$2.00 per hour to park there. If you have a Laconia Resident Beach sticker on your vehicle, you will not have to pay to park at the Endicott Rock Park parking lot, but you will have to pay for parking at the kiosks on Lakeside Avenue.

Please note that the parking enforcement described above does not apply during Laconia Motorcycle Week; please refer to the Temporary Traffic Order in effect from 6/11 thru 6/21.

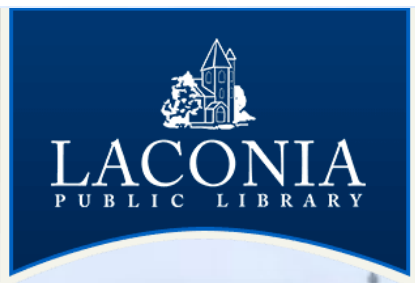

THEN . . .

Until late in 2019, this was the scene at Winnisquam Avenue, as seen from the Fair Street railroad crossing. The house at right was heavily damaged by fire, Sept. 2 of that year, and was torn down in mid-February 2020. (Google satellite shot)

Earlier this year, the house at 1 Winnisquam Avenue was rebuilt on the site of its predecessor. Meanwhile, steel is now rising for a boat storage facility on the lot behind Gouin & Son Plumbing and Heating (the red building, at left, that was home to the Belknap County Farmers Exchange in the 1920s and early 1930s). Site of the new boat storage facility was used at one time for coal and petroleum storage and a line of garages near Winnisquam Avenue was demolished in fall of 2019.
