## Golf and Disc Golf Tournaments at Bolduc Park



# Hello Medicare, is that really you?

Medicare will be conducting their Beneficiary Survey via phone due to the COVID-19 pandemic. If you are chosen for the survey, you will receive a letter to schedule a phone interview and alert you that NORC, a company working with Medicare, will be calling you.

Be aware that scammers often pretend to be from Medicare to steal your information. Don't give your personal information over the phone unless you can verify the caller. If you get a call and aren't sure it is legitimate, contact the Medicare surveyors (NORC) at 1-877-389-3429 to make sure it was really them calling.

## I LOST MY PROOF-OF-VACCINATION CARD. NOW WHAT?

All vaccination records are kept on file in the CDC National Health Interview Survey (NHIS) system.

NH DHHS advises that you can replace a lost vaccination card in either of two ways:

Note that the completed form **MUST BE NOTARIZED** before sending it back to NH DHHS. If your healthcare provider has access to the NHIS, ask him/her to print out the record directly from NHIS.



## THEN ...

From at least the 1940s, Pearson's Vegetable Stand was located next to 1261 Old North Main Street (the house at left, behind the foliage), and the cornfield extended back to the right, almost to the point where Old North Main leaves today's North Main Street — which was built in 1956-1957. William O. Pearson was listed in the 1940 City Directory as 'gardner and gas station.' By 1956, the listing was 'gardner and dairy farmer.' (Photo courtesy of Robert and Earline Pearson Sanborn)



## ... AND NOW

The Festival will be a day of Dragon Boat races, a flower ceremony for loved ones touched by cancer, and fun for anyone racing or watching!

Dragon Boating is easy to learn, extremely safe, and an activity where men and women compete side-by-side towards the same goal. Dragon boats are long, narrow (40 feet long) boats. The crew consists of 20 paddlers sitting two abreast, one steersperson at the rear, and one drummer who sits or stands at the head of the boat and beats out a paddling rhythm for the crew. Regardless of how young, old, big, or little: once a paddler is in stroke, they are contributing to their team! Add the outdoors, the water, the visual spectacle of dragon boating, and you get a perfect activity for friends and family!

Absolutely no experience is necessary to participate. We provide the boats, paddles, life jackets, a time to practice, and the racecourse! We recommend about 21-24 participants per team, with both men and women participating. The minimum age to paddle is 13 years old.

**Participation is easy – 1) create your team, 2) designate a Captain, 3) have the Captain register your team at the Gilda's Club NH website, and 4) agree to raise a designated minimum amount in donations for Gilda's Club New Hampshire.**


