



The City asks that all residents be good neighbors and not park or block sidewalks with their cars and trucks. Blocking sidewalks with vehicles prevents the City from plowing and sanding the sidewalks which causes pedestrians to walk in the streets.

We also ask that snow plow contractors and residents not plow or blow their snow across the street. This is a hazard to drivers that could result in a driver losing control and crashing.

Please be sure to give the City's plow trucks plenty of space as they are plowing the roads. Getting too close behind them may cause salt crystals to spray against your vehicle.

THEN ...

Bank Square, Laconia, is seen in the 1950s, with Santa's Workshop in front of Woolworth's, at left, and Santa's sleigh next to the Christmas tree. At right, the Laconia Federal Savings & Loan Association occupied the white building (formerly a First National store and, later, a Whelan Drug Store) in late December 1954. The Laconia National Bank began construction of the red brick building, beginning in 1888, with completion in mid-March 1889. (Facebook Photo)



... AND NOW

With Urban Renewal, Bank Square was made considerably smaller and the traffic island was eliminated. The Savings & Loan building is now a branch of Citizens Bank, while the Laconia National Bank building is today part of the Lakes Region Mental Health Center. The Laconia National and City Savings banks building was expanded and remodeled, with a Colonial brick and marble facade, in 1957-1958. The Landau Co. built a new store (later Newberry's and Bloom's) now the Laconia Antiques Center on the far corner of Hanover Street in 1950. (Daniel Sarch/The Laconia Daily Sun)
