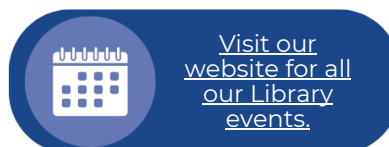

The City of Laconia is proceeding with the project involving the Centenary Avenue Bridge.

As part of the regulated process for this federally funded project, the City is hosting a Public Input Session. The meeting will be held on **Wednesday, May 15 at 6:00 PM** in Council Chambers at Laconia City Hall, located at 45 Beacon Street E in Laconia, New Hampshire.

The purpose of this meeting is to provide a general overview of the Centenary Avenue Bridge, summarize the findings from the September 15, 2023 charrette, and receive input from the general public before the City begins the design process. Your attendance would be appreciated and feedback is encouraged.

During the week of May 13 - May 17 the City's contractor will pick up an additional 10 bags of leaves on your normal trash day. All materials must be placed in paper compost bags.

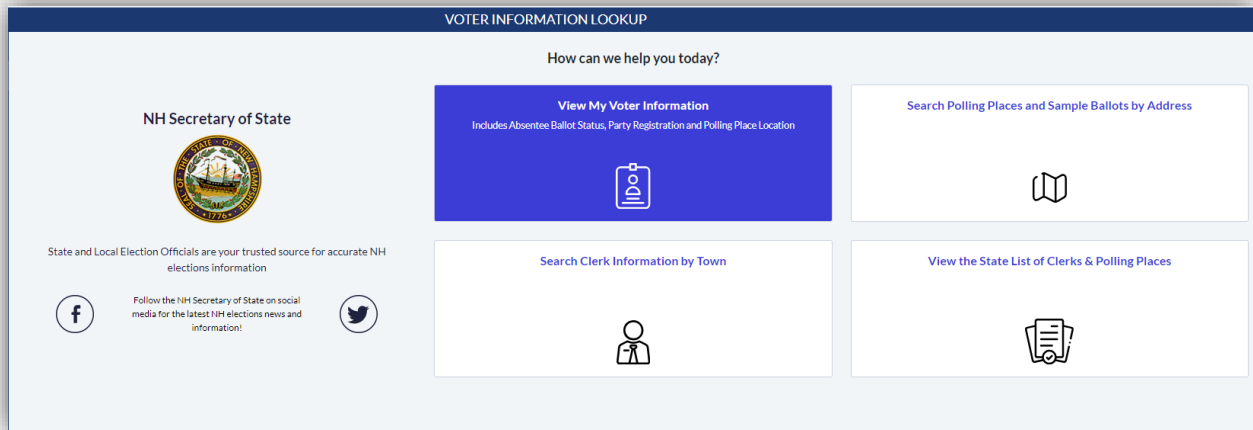

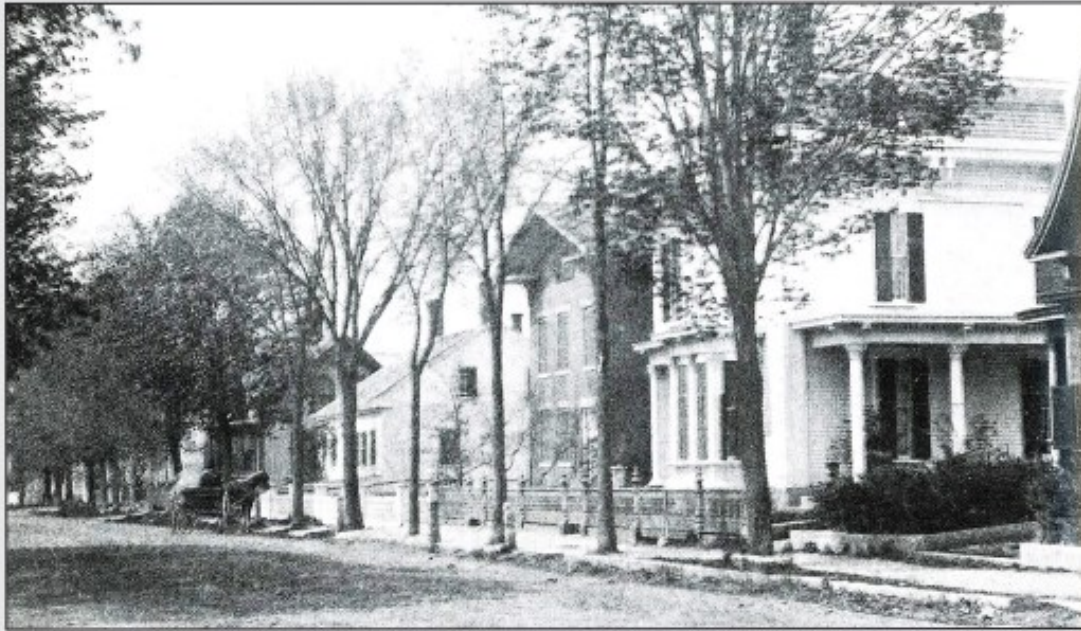

THEN ...

West side of Union Avenue, south of Lakeport Square, Laconia (but then still in the town of Gilford), is seen in the 1870s. White 'Cape' at left was later home to the Clow Sisters 12-room Gift House. The white home at right was that of Stephen B. Cole, steamboat captain and prominent businessman. Laconia Historical and Museum Society)



... AND NOW

In the 1960s, the Stephen Cole House was home to Jimmy's Bakery and, later, was occupied by the Lakeport Deli, Steamburger Heaven and Lakeport Roast Beef Sandwich Shop. The house burned in early January, 1997. The Clow Sisters 12-Room Gift House was a landmark at 678 Union Ave., from the early 1930s to around 1965. A serious fire damaged the building, Jan. 18, 1948, destroying a large barn and the Tyler Sign Shop in the rear. The Gift House was repaired within a few months and a new section added at the rear. By the late 1960s, however, the gift shop business and building were gone. The Belknap Tire Co. relocated here, from Lower Court Street, in the mi-1950s. Following a fire which destroyed its recapping plant in April 1962, the firm expanded with a two-story fireproof tire warehouse. (Daniel Sarch/The Laconia Daily Sun)

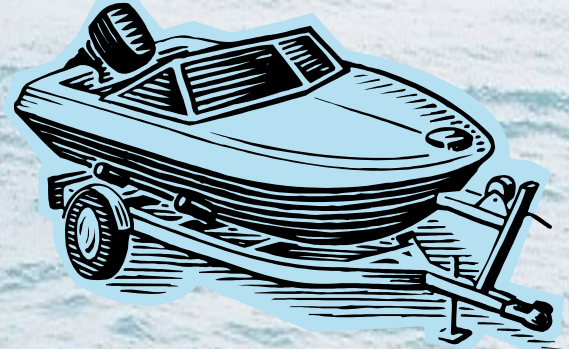

It's Not Too Early to Get Your 2024 Boat Registration!



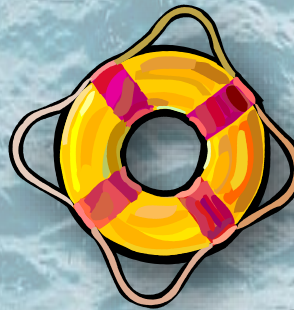
Did you know you can process your boat registration at the same time as you conduct other business at City Hall?

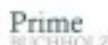
