




# Our yesterdays

## THEN ...

This was what a part of Union Avenue in Lakeport looked like, in late September 1925. House in background is on Mechanic Street. House glimpsed at right is at 603 Union Ave. The large sandpile occupied space between Union Avenue and Mechanic Street and was removed in late 1944 to be used as fill off Strafford Street, in what is now the Bisson Avenue section, and at several other sites. At time of photo, several large billboards lined Union Avenue, off-photo at left. (Laconia Historical and Museum Society)



## ... AND NOW

The sandpile had been removed in 1944, in anticipation of Cantin Chevrolet's 1947 move, after World War II, from 426 South Main St., to this location. The Dr. Clarence Rowe House at 603 Union Ave., in the earlier photo, would have been located at the north (left) corner of Mechanic Street and Union Avenue, now part of the Irwin Chevrolet dealership display lot. The Rowe House was moved back on the lot in 1955, to become the Baker Nursing Home and was demolished in 2013. (Daniel Sarch/The Laconia Daily Sun)

To help our neighbors and our environment, please bring the clean soft plastics you've been saving for proper repurposing.




