



Our yesterdays

Our sincere thanks to Warren D. Huse, the Laconia Historical and Museum Society, and the Laconia Daily Sun for providing a glimpse into our community's past.....



THEN ...

Lakeside Avenue, Weirs Beach, is seen in the late 1980s. The then-new Winnipesaukee Flagship Corp. 'station' (extreme left) was built in 1987, replacing an art deco 'Municipal Building' erected by the city of Laconia in 1940 following a 1939 fire that also took out the Steamer Mount Washington. Nothin' Fancy occupied space in the building at the far right. Adjoining building with gambrel roof was the longtime home of the Masseck (later Pinney's) Gift Shop. Building further left, at corner of Tower Street, opened as Carlson's Arcade, June 23, 1950. (Laconia Historical and Museum Society)



... AND NOW

Roughly three decades later, the buildings at right on Lakeside Avenue are still there, but the occupants have changed. Carlson's Arcade and the former Masseck-Pinney gift shop (Sidecar Sports Bar) are now part of today's Tower Hill Tavern. Nothin' Fancy became the Crazy Gringo from 2006-2024 and is now 'The Fancy,' an allusion by current owner Anthony Santagate to its earlier incarnation. Weathervane's 'Lobster in the Rough' replaced smaller buildings at left. (Daniel Sarch/The Laconia Daily Sun)
