PARKING ENFORCEMENT IN WEIRS BEACH BEGINS MAY 24!

Beginning Saturday, May 24, 2025 vehicles parking in the public parking spaces on Lakeside Avenue and in the Endicott Rock Park parking lot must pay to use the parking spaces. 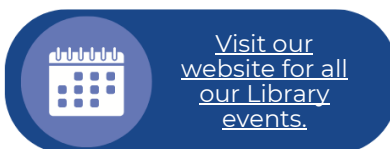

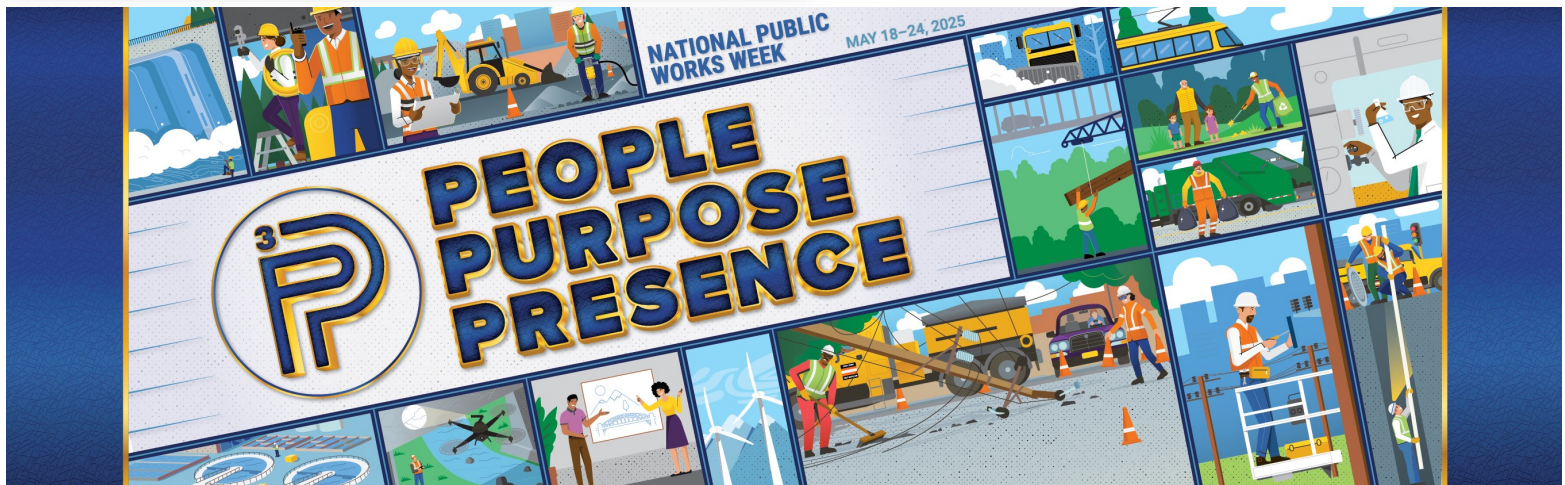

July 18, 1889

The Laconia Police Department honors the courageous men and women in law enforcement who made the ultimate sacrifice in service to their communities.

We pay special tribute to Officer Charles Dolloff, who gave his life in the line of duty on July 18, 1889. While responding to a violent disturbance at the Horse Races during the Laconia Fair, Officer Dolloff took swift action to restore peace. Shortly after, he resumed patrol and tragically suffered a fatal brain aneurism.

His legacy—and the legacy of all fallen officers—lives on through our continued service and remembrance.

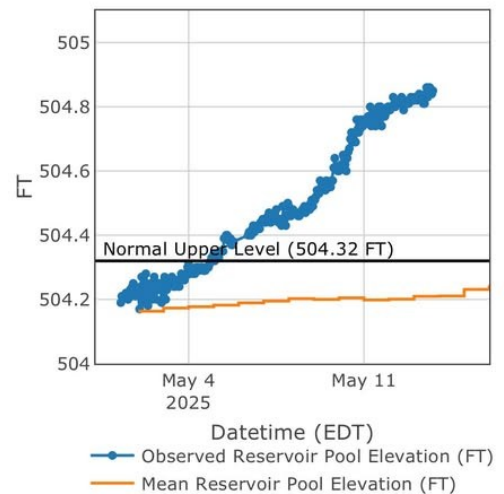

Lake Winnepesaukee (WEIN3)



Lake Winnepesaukee Alliance has reported that as of May 13 the level of Lake Winnepesaukee is 504.82 feet—that's 6 inches above full lake level (504.32').

Current outflow is 1150 cfs (cubic feet per second) and will be increased to 1350 cfs to help manage water levels.

With higher water levels, shorelines and docks are especially vulnerable to erosion and damage.

Please be mindful of your wake—even small boats can cause significant impacts in high water conditions.

Help protect our lake and our shoreline communities by keeping speeds down near shore and avoiding unnecessary wake.

Hosted by the City of Laconia, the workshop is a collaborative effort with Meredith Village Savings Bank and the New Hampshire Homebuilders Association.

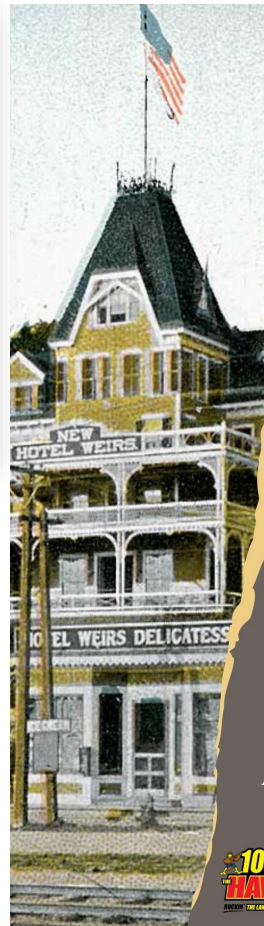

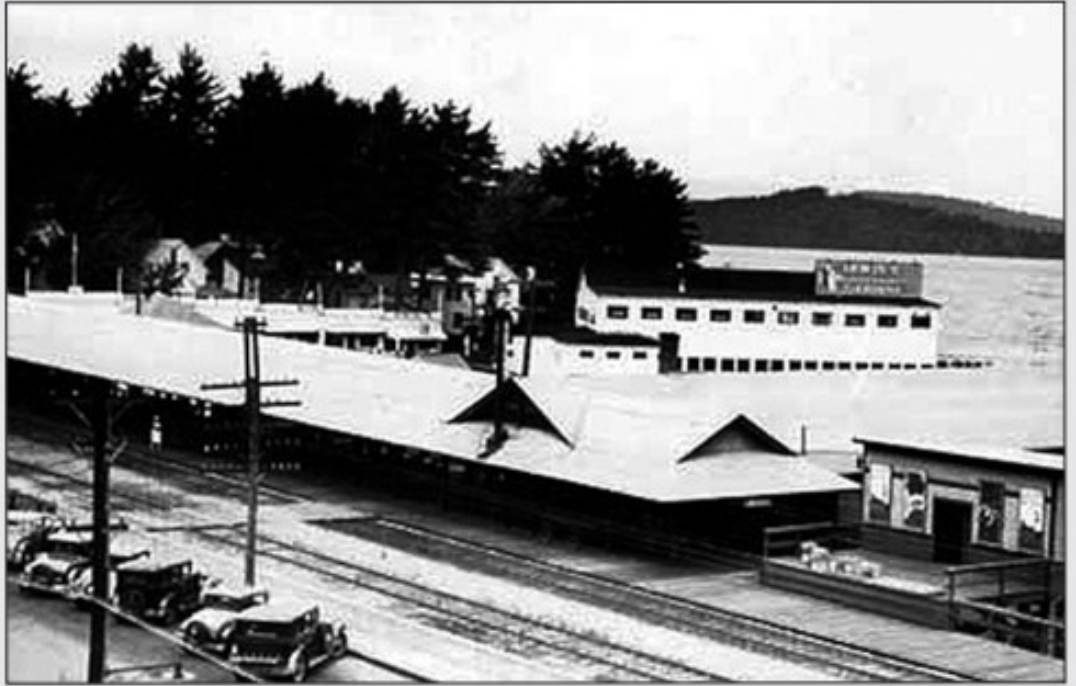
