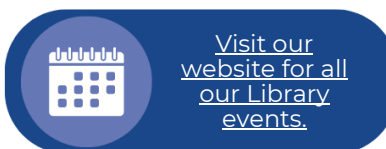

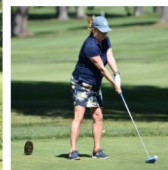

EBENEZER SMITH, MEREDITH'S PRIME MOVER: BIOGRAPHY OF A FOUNDING FATHER

Rudy VanVeghten was born and raised in Manchester, Vermont. He began his career as a journalist at the Meredith News in 1973, spending most of that time as editor.

After leaving Meredith in 2001, Rudy worked in publications and website management at his alma mater, Northeastern University in Boston, until moving back to Meredith following his retirement in 2020.

VanVeghten is the author of five books on Meredith history. The most recent, "Ebenezer Smith, Meredith's Prime Mover: Biography of a Founding Father," delves deep into the life and times of the one individual who championed the cause of settling the township that today encompasses Meredith, Laconia, and Center Harbor Village.

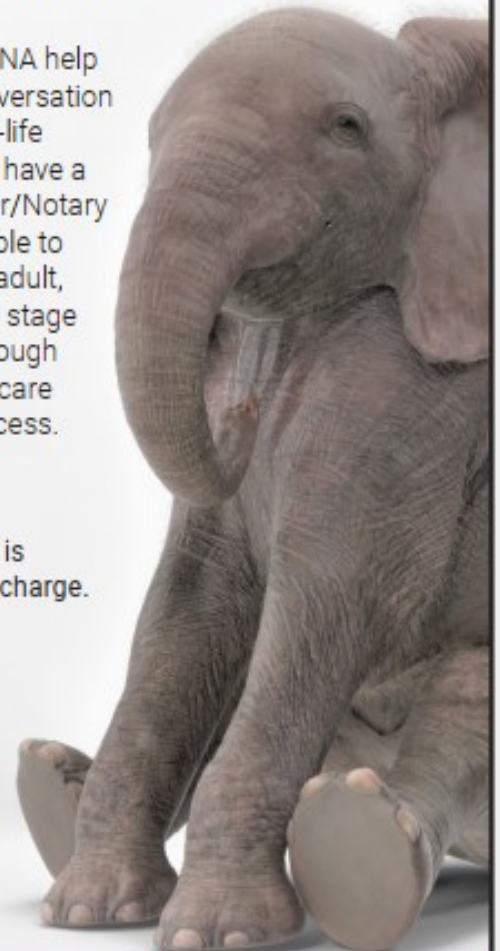

LACONIA WATER DEPARTMENT NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Laconia Water Department will be holding a public hearing on **Tuesday, August 12th, 2025**, to gather comments on raising its base rate from \$25.00 to \$28.75 per unit per quarter and consumption rate from \$2.55 to \$2.81 per hundred cubic feet (hcf). The meeting will be in the Laconia City Hall Council Chamber, Room 200A, beginning at 6:00 pm.

This increase is necessary as the operational and maintenance costs of the department have been steadily rising. The department also foresees considerable infrastructure upgrades in the near future. All other rates will remain unchanged.

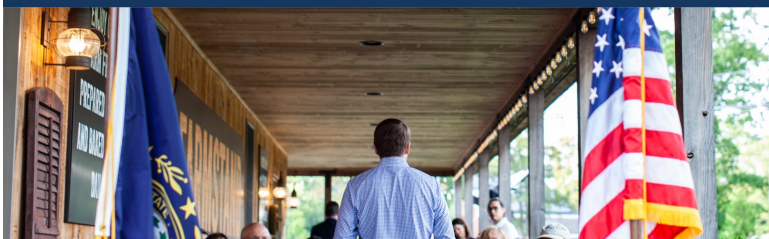

Our Yesterdays

Our sincere thanks to Warren D. Huse, the Laconia Historical and Museum Society, and the Laconia Daily Sun for providing a glimpse into our community's past...

Smith Block on Main Street sold to Tilton in 1925

Sale of the Smith Block on Main Street by the Samuel B. Smith heirs to Frank P. Tilton was "an event of interest to those who remember the history of the old building," *The Laconia Democrat* reported, 100 years ago this week. "The block, erected almost 40 years ago (late 1885-early 1886), was one of the first substantial buildings in Laconia." The "big big firm of Smith, Lougee Bros. was established down by the bridge," the 1925 article continued. "The Lougee Brothers occupied the new building and Oscar Lougee still retains one half of it. Much interesting history might be written of the Smith Block." (Note: Smith was the second mayor of Laconia, 1895-1897. Known — to most persons who remember it today — as the Tilton Block, the imposing structure was demolished in 1970 during the city's Urban Renewal Program. The site is now occupied by the Best Western Plus Landmark Inn)



THEN ...

Motorcyclists parade down Laconia's Main Street in the 1950s or early 1960s. Tilton (formerly Smith) Block is at left, with Oscar A.
