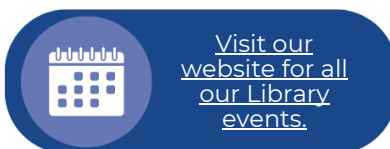

Each week from mid-Aug. to Sept., receive 'bucks' valued at \$20 to spend at the farmers' markets listed above. **NOTE: Markets run to early October, Veterans' Bucks may not.** Must be a US Military Veteran, or active duty, and able to provide documentation.

Valid forms of identification include: DD214, VA Healthcare card, NH Drivers License with a Veteran designation, or a Retired Military card.

Bucks must be used only at market location printed on the ticket-type 'bucks'.

Use of bucks is only valid for the purchase of food (vegetables/fruit, meat, dairy, bakery items).

**How to obtain Veterans' Bucks.** Visit the Veterans' Bucks booth at the market of choice and show valid identification. Bucks are available until grant funding is expended.

Public Safety Answering Points (PSAPs)



Did you know New Hampshire 911 has two Public Safety Answering Points (PSAPs), located in Concord and Laconia, but they work together as part of a single, seamless system?

When you call 911, your call isn't directed based on which location is closer. Instead, every call is routed to the telecommunicator who has been available the longest between the two facilities, ensuring the fastest possible response.

No matter where you are in the state, help is just a call or text away.

At the August 25, 2025 Laconia City Council meeting several Proclamations were presented:

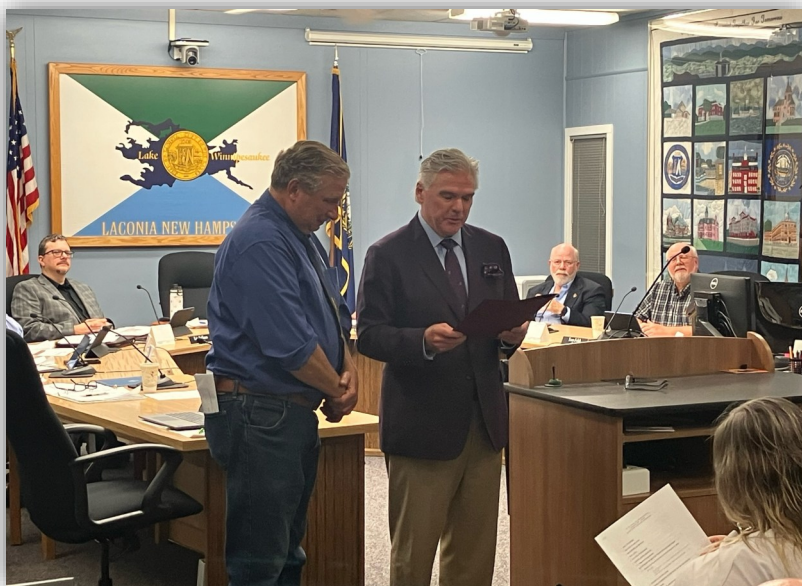
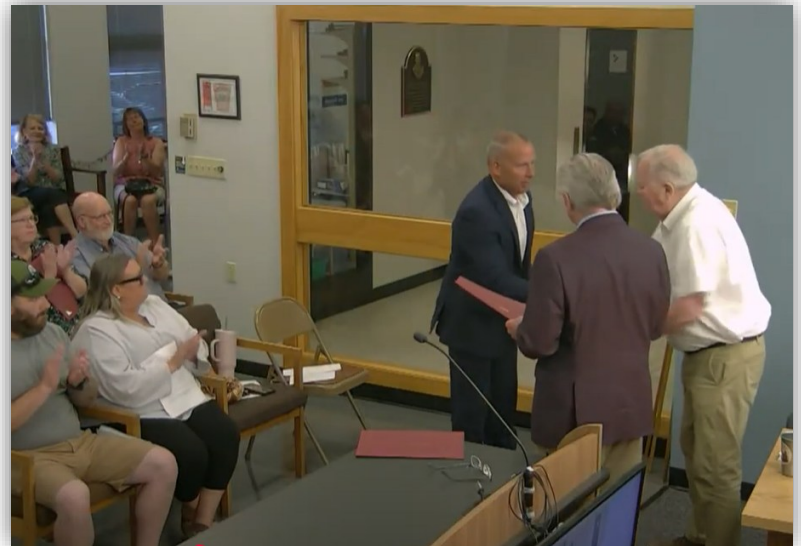
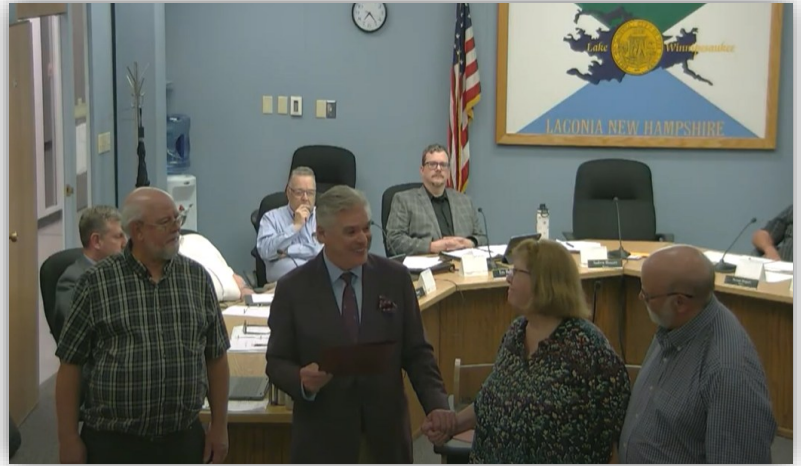
To Bill and Paula Gile for their many contributions to the community and their work with the Got Lunch! Laconia program;

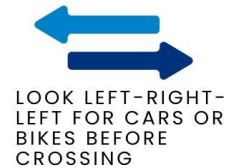
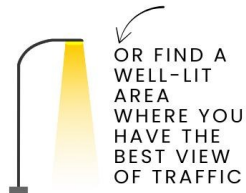
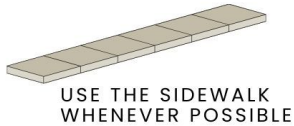

# Our Yesterdays

## THEN ...

**This brick hydro-electric power plant, at the end of a wing dam on the west side of the Winnepesaukee River, in Lakeport, replaced an earlier wooden building, destroyed in the Great Lakeport Fire of May 26, 1903. The Boulia-Gorrell Lumber Co. is seen behind it and Lake Opechee is seen in the distance. (Laconia Historical and Museum Society)**



## ... AND NOW

**According to WeirsBeach.com, the hydro-electric plant was retired in 1932. The wing dam, built in 1861 to serve several mills downstream, was filled in around 1957, but the stonework remains.
