Stories, songs, and a craft. For children birth through age 6 and a parent or caregiver.



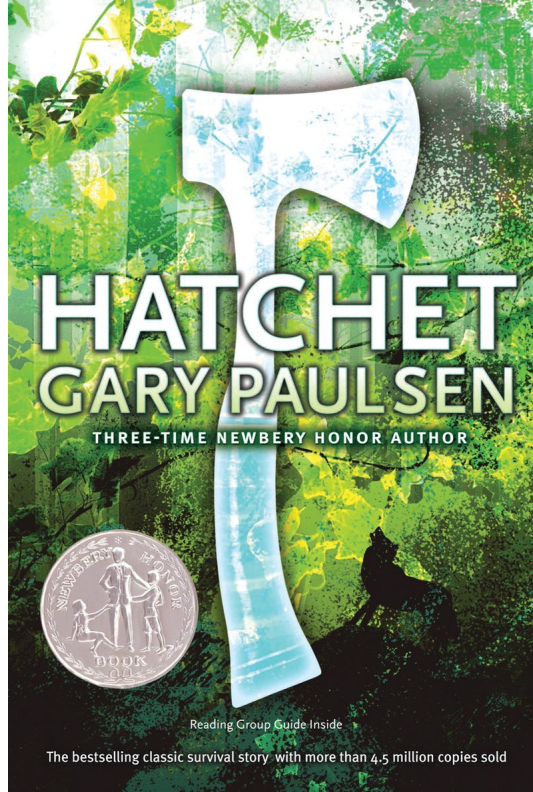

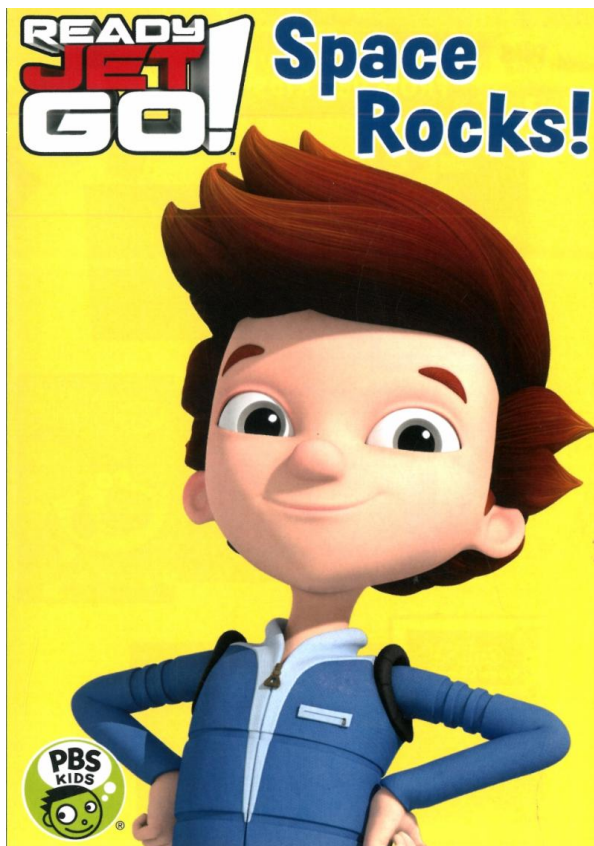
