

Let's Create! Fluid Painted Ornament

Supplies

- Wood slice
- Painters tape (shared)
- Paint, 2-4 colors
- 1 cup per color, plus 1 for mixing
- 1 larger container
- Ribbon
- Scissors
- Fluid medium (shared)
- Gloves

Steps

1. Tape the bottom and sides of the wood slice with painter's tape.
2. Cut the tape flush with the top of the wood on one side
3. Mix a equal parts paint and fluid medium (you don't need very much paint at all). The cup should be less than half full after mixing.
4. Layer the paint in a cup by pouring into the center. Do not stir or the colors will become muddy.
5. Once your layers are poured, then place your wood slice into the larger sandwich container.
6. You may pour your paint on top of your wood slice, or you may place the wood slice on top of your paint cup, flip over the cup while holding it securely to the wood slice, and then remove the cup straight up for another effect.
7. You can fish out the wood gently from the paint and let it dry on the lid.
