

# ADULT CRAFT: SQUEEGEE ART

## SUPPLIES

- Paint
- Squeegee
- Painters tape
- Paint pens or Sharpies
- Paper
- Stick (optional)

## DIRECTIONS

Practice drawing with the paint bottles. You want to squeeze very gently so that not much comes out at once, you only need a little paint. You can also paint a drop and then drag it out with the stick for more control.



1. Tape the paper down with painter's tape so it doesn't move when you're working
2. Squeeze a small line of white paint across the paper length of the paper
3. Drag a squeegee to spread a thin layer of paint across the whole sheet

### If drawing cats:

4. Using the paint bottle, draw an M shape of paint in a color of your choice about  $\frac{1}{4}$  the width of the paper
  - Alternatively, draw a straight line and push the points up with a stick to make the ears
5. Place the squeegee above the paint line and press firmly while dragging straight down over the paint, let go once off the paper.
6. Wipe off the squeegee

### If not drawing cats, do whatever shape you like!

### Tips:

- Let dry some, if overlapping (it shouldn't take too long as they're thin layers)
  - Work light to dark or front to back with drying between
  - You can also dab with a paper towel to create the look of fluffy fur
7. Repeat as many times as desired for more cats or shapes
  8. Once dry, you can draw details with a paint pen or marker. Or, if doing an abstract, you may want to outline the overlapping parts for contrast (You can place a paper towel under your hand to avoid smudges when drawing)
  9. Remove the painter's tape gently, to avoid tearing the paper
