Contractors are required to contact the Laconia Fire Department Central Station and Lakes Region Fire Communications Center 30 minutes prior to each blasting event.

Surface blasting conducted only during daylight hours.

Administrative Requirements of Permit Issuance:

- Copy of Blasters Certificate on file at Laconia Fire Department
- Copy of Blasters Certificate of Insurance on file at Laconia Fire Department
- Permit MUST be posted or in the control of the supervising blaster on-site.
- Payment of permit fee - \$60.00 initial - \$ 30.00 Renewal (each valid for 30 days)

Safety Requirements of Permit Issuance:

- Non-sparking tools in use.
- Blasting mats present and used.
- NO RADIO TRANSMISSION signs posted.
- Sirens or signal available for notification prior to blast.
- Magazine area must be clear of brush or debris for at least 25 feet.
- Utilities must be notified 24 hours prior to blasting where operations will impact utilities.
- Magazine must be supervised at all times.
- Two fire extinguishers must be located with Type 5 magazine (4-A:20-BC).
- No unauthorized personnel allowed where explosives are being handled.
- Explosive placard must be affixed to Type 5 mobile magazine unless empty.
- Vehicular magazine must be made immobile when left unmanned.
- No combustible materials allowed within 50 feet of magazine.
