

# Mini Mason Jar Candle

## Adult Craft Instructions

### Supplies

- 2 - wood sticks
- 1 - 4oz mason jar with handle
- 1 - wick
- 1 cup wax flakes
- 1/4 crayon, crushed into small bits
- 1/2 tsp liquid scent\*
- \*(I'll measure this out once you're ready since I only have the one measuring spoon)



### Directions

1. Place your candlewick in a mason jar
2. To hold the wick in place, wrap the top around the wood stick making sure that the metal piece touches the bottom
3. Measure out 1 cup of soy wax into a Dixie cup (it shouldn't overflow, but it will close to the top)
4. Decorate your jar using the ribbon, fabric or other supplies available
5. Heat the wax in 30 second intervals, stirring well between each with the second wood stick
6. **\*\*We will take turns since there is only one microwave**
7. After four rotations (2 minutes total) the wax should be almost all the way melted and clear
8. Crush up 1/4 of a crayon (remove all paper from the crayon) and add to the melted wax
9. Microwave one final 30 second burst, then stir well
10. Add in scent of choice and stir
11. Pour carefully into glass jar. To make the pouring easier, squish the Dixie cup to make a spout
12. Store the candle in a cool place until it sets. Do not touch while it's setting. It may take 3-4 hours.
13. We can leave the candles here to set, and you can come back for them later. They will be hot to touch until it cools.
