

# Painted Glassware

## Adult Craft

### DIRECTIONS

#### Step 1: Clean your glass.

Wipe the glass you've chosen with a damp paper towel of rubbing alcohol to remove any oil from hands, or dust. Let air dry.

#### Step 2: Choose your design.

There is paper and pencil available if you'd like to experiment with designs. I've printed some example line art designs that you can copy.

Or, you can cut out and tape a design to the inside of your glass to trace.

#### Step 3: Paint.

We are using oil-based Sharpie markers. Dab the tip on a paper towel to get the paint flowing, then use as you would any marker.

Mistakes can be cleaned up with a swipe of rubbing alcohol.

*Note: Do not decorate the inside, or anywhere that may come into contact with your mouth.*

### AT HOME DIRECTIONS

To preserve the design, the glass must be baked.

1. Allow the glasses to dry for at least 20 minutes.
2. Place in cold oven.
3. Heat the oven to 350 degrees, turn on time to 20 minutes, and allow glasses to cook.
4. Turn off the oven and allow glasses to cool before removing.

*Note: The finished glass should be hand washed to make the design last longer.*
