

MARBLEIZED WINE GLASSES

HYDROPAINTING WITH NAIL POLISH!

Supplies

- Nail polish in a selection of colors
- Wine glass
- Stick
- Pan with water

Directions



- 1) Fill water into your pan with pitcher (or at the sink if you're sturdy enough) – it does not need to be filled all the way up
- 2) Shake your nail polish jars, then open all colors you're going to use
- 3) Rinse and dry your glass
- 4) Tape around the drinking edge with painters tape. Cover the whole mouth of the glass.
- 5) Working quickly so that the polish doesn't dry and lose the ability to swirl:
- 6) Drop in nail polish one drop at a time, into the center. It should bead up on top, and not sink. If it does sink, just keep dropping more drops in. Smaller drops work better at first.
- 7) Using your stick, swirl through the colors to make a pattern
- 8) Gently dip, or roll, your glass into the nail polish until it picks up the colors
- 9) Repeat as many times as you want on your glass to create your design
- 10) Wash your glass by hand once you've used it to preserve the design.
