

Star Art Splatter Painting

MATERIALS

- Newspaper
- Black construction paper
- White paper
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Plate
- Round items for making circles
- White/Light blue paint
- Pencil
- Silver or white marker or crayon
- Watercolor paints
- Q-tips (optional)



STEPS

1. Draw circles on white paper (use different size circular shapes to trace).
2. Paint inside the circles with watercolor paints to make multi-colored planets.
3. While the planets dry, pour a small amount of white paint onto a paint (we used light blue paint too).
4. Add a few drops of water to the paint and stir around.
5. Dip the paintbrush into the paint, and tap the brush to splatter paint on the black construction paper.
6. Repeat until the paper has as many stars as you would like.
7. If making the solar system, cut out the planets, and glue them to the black paper.
8. If making a constellation, write a word of your choosing on the black paper in white marker or crayon. Add dots at the ends of letters to make stars.
