

Fall Tree Painting

Supplies Needed:

- Light blue, brown and green construction paper
- Red, yellow and orange paint
- Clothespin
- Glue stick
- 3 cotton balls

INSTRUCTIONS

- Glue brown paper tree onto blue paper.
- Glue green grass to the bottom of the blue paper.
- Pick up a cotton ball with the clothespin.
- Dip the cotton ball in your first paint color, and start painting spots all over the tree.
- Move on to your next color, and then the third, switching out cotton balls each time you change colors. Fill your tree with as many leaves as you would like. You can even add some to the ground!
- Wait for your tree to dry, and then hang it up, so you can see the pretty fall colors inside all season long!
