Supplies:

- Clothespin
- Brown paint
- Red and yellow construction paper
- Googly eyes
- Coffee filter
- Markers
- Spray bottle with water
- Glue

Instructions:

- Color your coffee filter with Crayola markers. (We used brown, red, orange, and purple.)
- Lightly spray your coffee filter with water. The colors will start to run together.
- The coffee filter will take a while to dry. While it dries, paint the clothespin brown.
- When the brown paint is dry, glue two google eyes near the top.
- Cut a little turkey wattle out of red construction paper (shaped like a mini hockey stick).
- Cut a small beak out of yellow construction paper.
- Glue the wattle and beak below the googly eyes.
- When the coffee filter is dry, fold it in half, with the flat end on the bottom.
- Pinch the clothespin open, and push the coffee filter lightly into the end you've just opened.
