

Adult Takeaway Craft

Gingerbread House Ornaments

Supplies

Included

- Paint
- Paintbrush
- Foam brush
- Stick
- Mini flower pot

- Ribbon
- Silver bell

You will need

- Water cup for rinsing brushes
- Newspaper to cover table
- Tape (optional)



Directions

1. Wipe off flower pot of any debris
2. Use the foam brush to paint the top and raised edge around the lip of the pot with white—dab with the edge of the foam to create textured brush strokes
3. Using the wooden bottom of the foam brush, dap circles of white paint around the bottom edge of the pot
4. Use the paintbrush to paint on a door and windows
5. Use the stick for detail work like dots or stripes
6. Let the paint dry between colors so that they don't blend
7. Once your design is complete, slide the bell onto the ribbon and pull it through to the middle
8. Thread the ribbon, with the bell, through the hole from the top to the inside of the flower pot. Use a piece of tape to wrap the edges to make it easier to thread
9. Tie a slipknot at the end of the ribbon then pull the ribbon back through the top of the flower pot
10. Slide the bell down to the base of the flowerpot
